- No refunds or exchanges are made unless the show is canceled.
- Please indicate if a wheelchair accessible seat is needed, or of any other accommodations we can make to provide better access for patrons with any special needs; and do so as soon as possible to assure we can best accommodate you.
- All audience members, regardless of age or the performance location at Reston Community Center, are required by Virginia Fire Code to have a ticket.
- Tickets are not mailed. E-tickets will be sent electronically to the primary patron at least three days prior to the performance and will be scanned at the theatre door. Any issues regarding e-tickets can be addressed by calling the Box Office.
- To stay within state and county social distancing regulations for gatherings, only a limited number of seats will be available. Only pairs of tickets may be purchased online; patrons requesting an odd number of tickets should call the RCC Box Office (703-476-4500, Press "3"), or, they may visit the Box Office during normal hours (Tuesday – Thursday, 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.; Saturday, 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.) to select seats.
- Attendees must wear a mask, maintain social distancing and follow public health guidelines.
- Check your health; if you're not well, please stay home! If you have symptoms of COVID-19 or you've been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 14 days, don't attend.
