3D Gallery Exhibit Description

Reston-area ceramics, sculpture, beadwork, mosaics, stained glass, woodwork and other 3D artists are invited to be a part of this three-dimensional exhibit to celebrate the many facets of culture in Reston. Entries should reflect an aspect of your heritage. Three-dimensional artists are welcome to broadly interpret the meaning of culture in their entries. The words each artist writes will be on display with their works and are integral to the exhibit. Up to 10 pieces per artist will be accepted.

3D Gallery Entry Guidelines

- Original three-dimensional works that meet RCC guidelines (see Nature of ... below) will be accepted.
- **Affix a label to the bottom of each work** that includes your name or initials and price.
- Artist should bring their own display stands, risers, etc. labeled with their name.
- Sales are not conducted by RCC. Patrons will be directed to contact the artist, who is responsible for sales and sales taxes. Please include sales tax in the price. No sales commission will be charged by Reston Community Center.
- Sold art may be removed and a replacement brought in if coordinated with Rebecca Campana or Gloria Morrow.
- For size limitations, see 3D Gallery Information below.
- RCC Staff will make final placement decisions.

Nature of Reston Community Center Exhibits

Since Reston Community Center is a public facility utilized by all members of our community, the nature of daily activities requires some discretion in the type of work displayed. Work that is sexually explicit (work that is representational or realistic in depiction of human genitals will be considered sexually explicit by RCC) or graphically violent will not be considered appropriate to the space. Artwork that does not meet these guidelines will be removed by Reston Community Center staff and stored until the artist can be contacted. RCC staff and artists work together to create an atmosphere that is sensitive to the multi-use nature of the facility.

3D Gallery Information

Lighted display cases that line the walls of a 30-foot hallway display all types of pottery, sculpture and other three-dimensional works. Each display case is approximately 4' wide by 6' tall. Within each case are three 4' wide by 2' tall shelves. The bottom shelf is a black, hard-surface material with a depth of 14 inches and the upper two shelves are glass with a depth of 12.5 inches.

The back and sides of the entire display case are mirrored. The 3D Gallery is open to the public during RCC Lake Anne hours of operation, Monday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
