Therapeutic Recreation Services

Summertime calls for friends, fun and summer camp! Come join us at Therapeutic Recreation Services (TRS) summer camp 2024! The summer will be packed full of special events, art activities, sensory play, games, sports, outdoor play, music activities and more. All programming is designed to meet the different interests and abilities of the campers. All camp sites are open to participants with developmental disabilities, intellectual disabilities, autism spectrum disorder, physical disabilities, emotional disabilities, learning disabilities and/or attention deficit disorders. Each site will have a variety of staff to participant ratios available to meet the different needs of campers. Ratios range from 1:2 to 1:5 at each site.

Rec-PAC (Pretty Awesome Children), sponsored by the Fairfax County Park Authority, is an affordable, quality summer day program for children who have completed kindergarten through those entering seventh grade. A part of Fairfax County for more than 40 years, Rec-PAC serves thousands of local kids in 45 elementary schools around the county. The hours are 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Fees are on a sliding scale based on family income and are less than \$3.50 per hour. Scholarships and reduced fees are available for eligible families.

Activities revolve around a weekly theme and include sports and fitness, indoor/outdoor games, team sports, nature, crafts, storytelling, sports festivals, talent shows, supervised play sessions and special events. Children with disabilities may attend any location or select one of the specialized inclusion sites supported by trained inclusion staff. USDA breakfast and lunch are served at eligible locations. Teens in grades ninth – 12th may serve as Counselors-In-Training (CITs), which provides an opportunity to develop leadership skills and gain job experience. Registration begins in late April, and a complete list of locations will be available in late spring at www.fairfaxounty.gov/parks/rec-pac.






