RCC invites area artists to exhibit original two-dimensional work that can be sold for gift giving during this display. Up to two works per artist will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The \$5 per-work entry fee will be donated to Cornerstones. Artists are also encouraged to donate 10 percent of their sales to continue the important work of the Embry Rucker Community Shelter, the Laurel Learning Center and their Community Services Outreach Program. Jo Ann Rose Gallery Entry Guidelines

- Original two-dimensional works in any medium that meet RCC standards will be accepted. Work larger than 36" in any direction will count as two pieces. Off-white or white mattes and simple frames are preferred.
- **Note – New Hanging System:** The new system now **requires a hanging wire** on the back of each piece. Works must be securely framed. Gallery-wrapped canvases do not need to be framed unless there are visible staples. Canvas sides should be treated as part of the artwork. Works that are unsafe will be returned to the artist. Suggestions about hanging a piece are welcome but final decisions will be made by staff.
- **Place a temporary label on the front of pieces** with your name, title, and price. Permanent wall tags will be affixed later.
- Sales may be conducted during this special exhibit by RCC with permission from the artist. Artists are solely responsible for sales taxes, which should be included in price. RCC does not charge sales commission. Sold art may be replaced if coordinated with Cheri Danaher or Gloria Morrow.
- RCC will not accept responsibility for damaged or stolen work. Staff takes all possible care to safeguard the exhibit, but this is a public space and artists submit their work at their own risk.
- **Please do not enter "Not for Sale" items in this exhibit.**
- Everyone is invited to the Holiday Gift Shopping Event on December 7 from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Nature of Reston Community Center Exhibits

Since Reston Community Center is a public facility utilized by all members of our community, the nature of daily activities requires discretion in the type of work displayed. Work that is sexually explicit (work that is representational or realistic in depiction of human genitals will be considered sexually explicit by RCC), or is graphically violent will not be considered appropriate to the space. If artwork that does not meet these guidelines is inadvertently accepted, RCC reserves the right to store the work until the artist can be contacted. RCC staff and artists work together to create an atmosphere that is sensitive to the multi-use nature of the facility.

Jo Ann Rose Gallery Information

RCC Lake Anne opened in the fall of 1999 as a multi-use facility focused primarily on visual arts. Since that time, local artists have been able to participate in monthly exhibits in the Jo Ann Rose Gallery, a space where 40 or more works can be displayed. The Jo Ann Rose Gallery was dedicated to the memory of Reston artist Jo Ann Rose. Jo Ann was an elected member of the RCC Board of Governors and an active past president of the League of Reston Artists. She worked tirelessly for the creation of this unique space to celebrate the arts and artists of our community.
