Reston Community Center Photography/Videography Guidelines for the 2023 Reston Multicultural Festival

RESTON, VA — The Reston Multicultural Festival returns to Reston Town Center to celebrate Reston's rich diversity through song, dance, craft arts and community engagement on Saturday, September 23 from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Reston Community Center proudly presents the Reston Multicultural Festival in partnership with Reston Town Center Association (RTCA). BXP cohosts the expanded festival. Volunteer coordination is provided by Reston Association.

Media representatives are invited to attend the Reston Multicultural Festival on Saturday, September 23 from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Festival kicks off at the Pavilion Stage at 11:00 a.m. with elected officials from Reston, Fairfax County, and state and federal government, alongside our community partners.

Any persons using photographic, videographic, or other camera equipment representing either a bona fide media outlet (as vetted by Reston Community Center staff), or a festival performer, vendor or organization representative, must complete and sign the **2023 MEDIA PHOTOGRAPH AND/OR /VIDEOGRAPHY RELEASE** prior to using their equipment. The form can be obtained at Reston Community Center's Media Booth (#215) at the Multicultural Festival beginning at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, or in advance (no later than noon on Wednesday, September 20) by contacting RCC's Communications Director Lorna Campbell Clarke at Lorna.Campbell-Clarke@fairfaxcounty.gov.

Once the signed release is received and verified against the media or participant roster, a **MEDIA BADGE** will be issued via the RCC Media Booth at the Festival. The badge must be worn while equipment is in use at the Festival. Failure to sign a current release may result in the inability to photograph or video the Festival on any equipment other than a cell phone. Cell phones may be used without a release.
