Reston Community Center ceramics, sculpture, mosaics, stained glass, woodwork and other 3D teachers and students who have been registered in arts and/or crafts classes since January 2024 are invited to participate in this exhibit (teacher participation not required for students to enter).

All work submitted should relate to or be inspired by class work.

3D Gallery Entry Guidelines

- Original three-dimensional works that meet RCC guidelines will be accepted.
- **Affix a label to the bottom of each work** that includes your name, brief title of work and price.
- Artists should bring their own display stands, risers, etc. labeled with their name.
- For size limitations, see 3D Gallery Information below. RCC staff will make placement decisions. There is a \$1 entry fee per work.
- Sales are not conducted by RCC. Patrons will be directed to contact the artist, who is solely responsible for sales and sales taxes. Please include sales tax in the price. RCC does not charge sales commission.
- Sold art may be replaced if coordinated with Cheri Danaher or Gloria Morrow.
- Reston Community Center will not accept responsibility for damaged or stolen work. Staff takes all possible care to safeguard the exhibit, but artists submit work at their own risk.

Nature of Reston Community Center Exhibits

Since Reston Community Center is a public facility utilized by all members of our community, the nature of daily activities requires some discretion in the type of work displayed. Work that is sexually explicit (work that is representational or realistic in depiction of human genitals will be considered sexually explicit by RCC) or graphically violent will not be considered appropriate to the space. Artwork that does not meet these guidelines will be removed by Reston Community Center staff and stored until the artist can be contacted. RCC staff and artists work together to create an atmosphere that is sensitive to the multi-use nature of the facility.

3D Gallery Information

The 3D Gallery is a glorious result of RCC Lake Anne's 2011 renovation. Lighted display cases that line the walls of a 30-foot hallway display all types of pottery, sculpture and other three-dimensional works. Each display case is approximately 4' wide by 6' tall. Within each case are three 4' wide by 2' tall shelves. The bottom shelf is a black, hard surface material with a depth of 14" and the upper two shelves are glass with a depth of 12.5". The back and sides of the entire display case is mirrored. The 3D Gallery is open to the public during RCC Lake Anne hours of operation, Monday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
