#### Young at Art Entry Information

- Artists age 55+ are welcome to participate in this **FREE** exhibit at Reston Community Center Hunters Woods.
- **One original two-dimensional work** in any medium (painting, collage, photography, printmaking, stained glass, fiber, drawing, etc.) that meets RCC standards will be accepted. Off-white or white mattes and simple frames are preferred.
- Works must be **securely framed**, unless they are gallery-wrapped canvases. **Hanging wire is required** for the hanging system at RCC Hunters Woods. **Works submitted without a hanging wire or deemed unsafe will be returned to the artist.** **No clip-style frames.** RCC staff will make all placement and hanging decisions.
- **Please affix a label to the back lower corner of each work** that includes your name, phone number, title of the work and price.
- Works should not be removed before the end of the exhibit or picked up by anyone other than the artist unless prior arrangements are made with Gloria Morrow or Cheri Danaher.
- RCC staff will answer general questions about the exhibit, but will refer questions about sales directly to the artist. The artist is solely responsible for sales and sales taxes.
- RCC will not accept responsibility for damaged or stolen work. Staff takes all possible care to safeguard the exhibit, but this is a public space and artists submit their work at their own risk.

#### Nature of Reston Community Center Exhibits

Since Reston Community Center is a public facility utilized by all members of our community, the nature of daily activities requires some discretion in the type of work displayed. Work that is sexually explicit (work that is representational or realistic in depiction of human genitals will be considered sexually explicit by RCC) or is graphically violent will not be considered appropriate to the space. If artwork that does not meet these guidelines is accepted, Reston Community Center reserves the right to remove the work and store it until the artist can be contacted. Center staff and artists work together to create an atmosphere that is sensitive to the multi-use nature of the facility. RCC does not charge sales commission.
